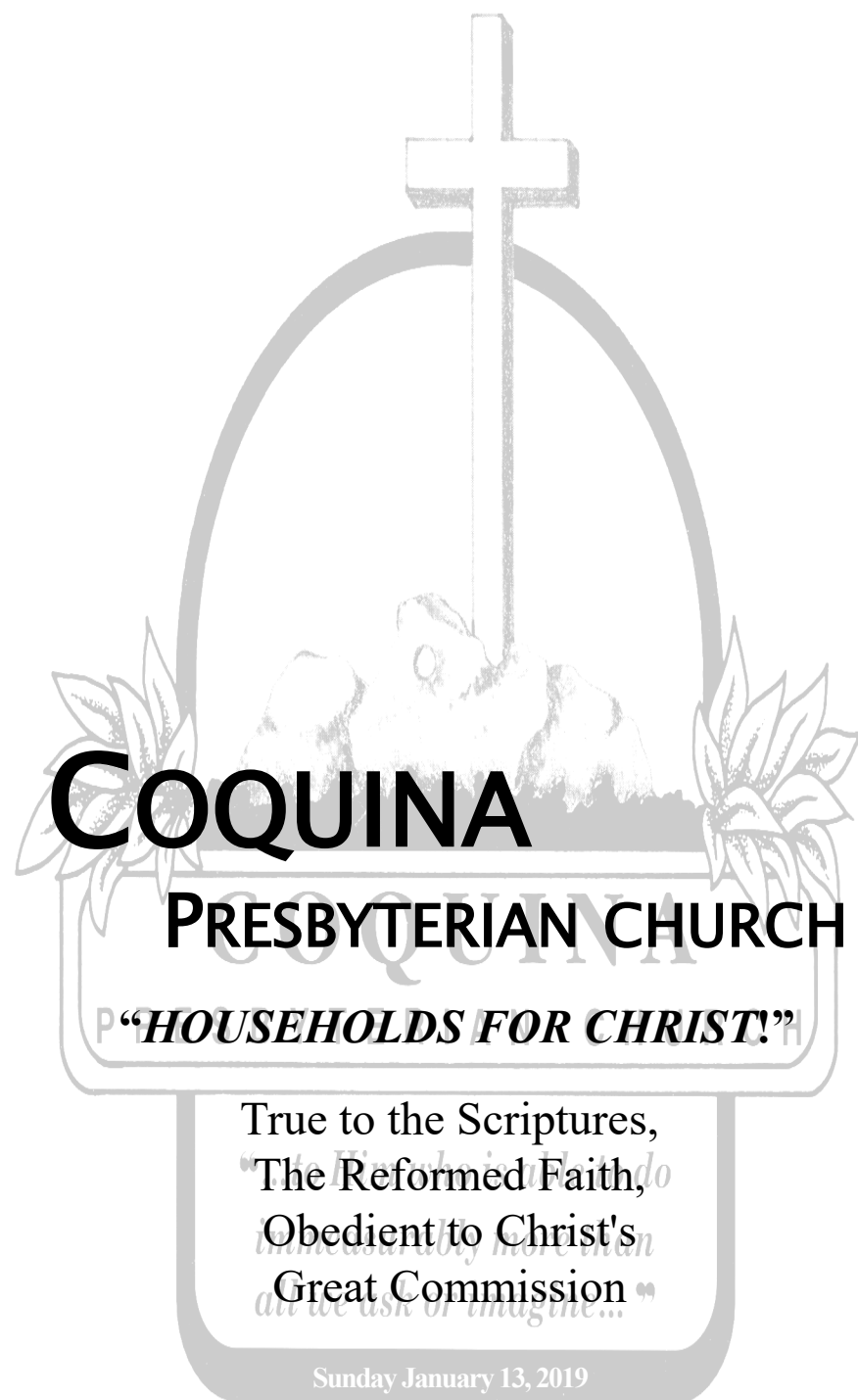

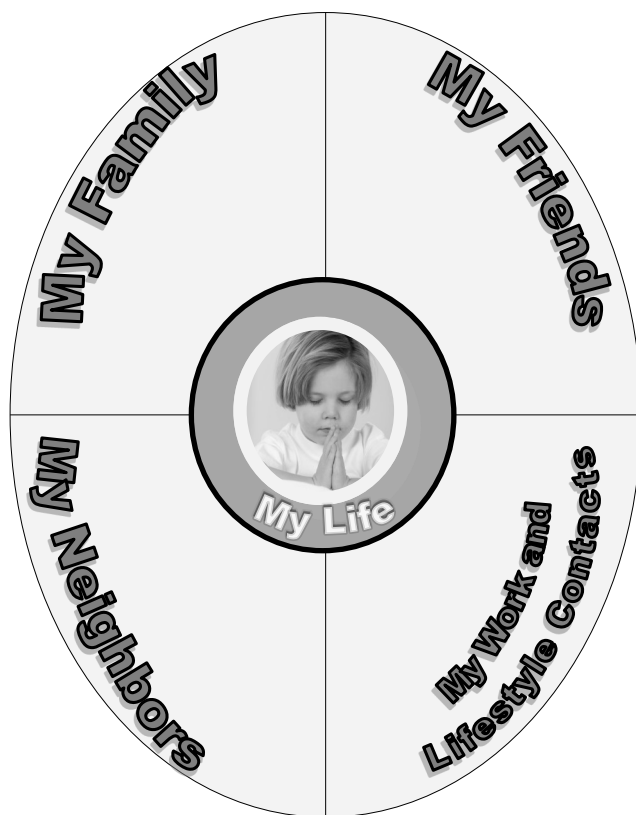


How did you do with Your “Mission Fields” In 2018?

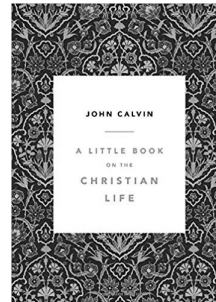

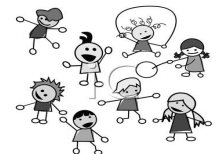
WOMEN'S DISCIPLESHIP BIBLE STUDY
